On Monday, August 18th, Adobe Mountain Wildlife Center transported a Swainson's Hawk to their facility from Keepers in order to continue the bird's rehabilitation. The hawk was rescued on June 26th by our Director, Jonathan Kraft, and our Assistant Director, Tina Matejek, while on their way to a function in Kingman. Observed disoriented and hobbling alongside Route 66, the hawk was suffering from a bullet wound to his wing. At the Adobe Mountain facility, he will be placed in a flight cage in order to determine when and if he can be released back into the wild. Updates on this hawk's recovery will continue.
